



Closing Huddle Day 2

Bible Point: Jesus loves me! Thank you, Jesus!

Bible Verse: "For the Lord is good; God's love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations." Psalm 100:5

Story: Woman at the Well - John 4:1-26

Materials Needed:

- Everyday use: Yoga mats or carpet squares, one per kid
- 1 bucket per crew
- 1 small dixie cup per participant
- Sunny Bible Buddy Button Pin

Set Up:

- Place yoga mats/ carpet squares in a circle, per crew
- Place the bucket in the middle of the circle
- Fill the bucket with water
- One small dixie cup

What to do:

Introduce it!

- **Crew Check In:** Sit in groups on yoga mats, check in with them about the day, and wait as other groups gather

Music: *King of Kings, Lord of Lords, Glory, Hallelujah, etc.*

- **Discuss it:** What is one thing you learned today about Jesus?
- **Share it:** Let each crew share what they learned, and then say: Jesus' love is abundant! It is overflowing! It is for all people! Jesus' loves you and me.

Practice the Bible Point:

Leader says: Jesus loves me!

Participants say: Thank you, Jesus!

Music: *I've Got the Joy, Joy, Joy*

Close It Out!

Say: Today for our closing activity we are going to play with water. If you don't like to get wet, you can still play just move outside of the circle. For our closing, we are going to have a Bible story pop-quiz! Here is how to play:

What to do:

1. Before the leader asks the question, participants fill up their dixie cup at their “well” bucket.
2. Standing on their yoga mat, once the question is read, the participant has to decide if the answer is true or false.
3. If the participant thinks the answer is true, the participant squats down.
4. If the participant thinks the answer is false, the participant stays standing.
5. Whether they are squatting or standing, the participants toss their water at others, next to them or across from them, or behind them.
6. Before the next question, participants refill their small dixie cups.
7. If their well runs dry, the team is out.
8. Those who wish not to get wet, can still play by squatting or standing.

Questions:

1. True or False: Jesus didn’t like the woman at the well.
2. True or False: Jesus was thirsty.
3. True or False: Jesus asked the woman at the well for a drink.
4. True or False: The woman at the well was happy to meet Jesus.
5. True or False: The woman at the well told no one that she met Jesus.
6. True or False: Jesus loved the woman at the well.
7. True or False: The world needs Jesus’ love to make it a better place.
8. True or False: Jesus loves me as much as Jesus loved the woman at the well.
9. True or False: I should keep Jesus’ love to myself.
10. True or False: Jesus shows up in our lives daily.

Practice the Bible Point

Leader says: Jesus loves me!

Participants say: Thank you, Jesus!

Music: *God is So Good*

Debrief it!

- **Huddle Questions:** What do you think it would be like to meet Jesus? What is one thing you would like to ask him? What is one thing you hope he would say to you?
- **Repeat After Me Bible Verse:** “For the LORD (point up) is good; God’s love (heart hands) endures forever, and God’s faithfulness to all generations (point to everyone).” (Psalm 100:5)

Music: *In the Beginning, etc*

- **Practice the Bible Point**

Leader says: Jesus loves me!

Participants say: Thank you, Jesus!

- **Pass Out Bible Buddy:** (button pin) Say: Sunny, the Sun Fish, our Bible buddy for today, reminds us that Jesus loves the whole world, and so can we!

Pray it out!

For each crew, have the participants and leaders place their mats/ carpet squares in a circle.

With a drum, play an even beat while kids hop, skip, or jump from mat to mat, square to square.

Say this prayer:

Dear God,

Today

we hop-hop-hop, (everyone hops)

we skip-skip-skip, (everyone skips)

we jump-jump-jump (everyone jumps)

as we pray, and thank you for Jesus who comes to play,

with us now and every day!

Amen.

Lord, remember us in your kingdom and teach us to pray:

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us sins as we forgive those who have sinned against us.

Save us from the time of trial

And deliver us from evil.

For the kingdom, and the power, and the glory are yours,

Now and forever.

Amen.

Once done, invite participants to look into the well. All the words and drawings needing forgiveness have disappeared.
