

Story & Stretch Day 1

Bible Point: What God creates, we celebrate! Bible Verse: God said, "Let there be light!"

CREATION

Story: Creation, pg 2 **Materials Needed:**

Everyday use: Yoga mats or carpet squares, one per kid

• Bible Buddy Poster: Tina Turtle

Set Up:

• Place yoga mats/ carpet squares out in groups

Gopher Costume

What to do:

Introduce it!

• **Crew Check In:** Instruct crew leaders to take out their crew leader check in sheet out and get ready for the morning!

Music: Hippo Song

- Intro Question: Welcome everyone to Story & Stretch! In our Bible story for today, we learn about God's creation. Quick turn to your crew leader, and everyone shares their favorite animal?
- **Shout Out**: Each group picks out the best animal that they came up with, and shouts out the animal sound.
- **Define it:** Creation is the first story in the Bible. It is a story that celebrates the world and everything in it.

Learn to Bible Point:

Leader says: What God creates, **Participants say:** we celebrate!

Music: I'll Do My Best (Theme Song)

Get to it!

Teach the Bible story to the kids with Emcee and Gopher.

Emce: Today we are going to learn the seven days of creation. Gopher, are you ready?

Gopher: Yep!

Emcee: Can you count to 7?

Gopher: Yep! (Counts loudly and slowly) 1-2-3-4-5-6-7

Emce: Ok, you and the kids will count, and I will share what happened on each day of creation.

There might even be some actions so follow Gopher.!

Gopher and Kids: Day 1!

Emcee: God said, "Let there be light (tree pose) and called it good!"

Gopher and Kids: Day 2!

Emce: God said, "Let there be sky (blow air loudly) and called it good!"

Gopher and Kids: Day 3!

Emcee: God said, "Let there be rain (pretend to rain), seas, trees and plants (tree pose) and

called them good!"

Gopher and Kids: Day 4!

Emcee: God said, "Let there be a sun, moon, and star (make fingers twinkle) and called them

good!"

Gopher and Kids: Day 5!

Emce: God said, "Let there be fish in the sea (swim around) and birds in the air (fly around)

and called them good!"

Gopher and Kids: Day 6!

Emcee: God said, "Let there be animals (make your favorite animal sound) and people and

called them good!"

Gopher and Kids: Day 7!

Emcee: God said, "Let's rest!" (Everyone falls down on the ground.)

Gopher: I have to go because I want to read this Bible story again! Bye everyone!

Bible Buddy - Tina Turtle

Here are four fun facts about Tina the Turtle, and why she is unique to creation:

- Tina has a shell that protects her from animals that would think she is lunch!
- Turtles eat things in creation, too. Land turtles eat beetles, fruit, and grass, and sea turtles like Tina eat everything including algae, squid, and jelly fish.
- Turtles have 50 bones!
- Turtles are one of the oldest reptiles as they go all the way back to the dinosaurs!

Tina Turtle needs creation to survive: from the ocean to the sand, from algae to octopus.
