Bible Point: How God heals, we celebrate!

Bible Verse: Naaman went home praising and thanking God!

### Naaman

**Home Huddle Storytime & Questions:** Read together the story of Naaman is Healed in your Spark Story Bible found on page 148. Once done reading, ask: What was wrong with Naaman? How was he healed? What do you think about healing? How are the ways we can help heal the world?

### Let's Do Some Art!

**Materials Included:** Sterile Strips (bandaids), washi tape

**Materials From Home:** Scissors

**What to do:** Decorate bandaids. Sometimes we get hurt and need to be healed. If our feelings get hurt, using our words and sharing how we feel can help us heal. Sometimes a smile from someone can heal us if we are having a bad day. If we get a cut or scrape, a bandage can help us heal. We are going to decorate bandaids to give to friends or family members to help them heal and smile!

If you are decorating bandaids for play time, you can open the bandaid and decorate the actual bandaid. If you are going to give it to someone to help heal a wound, you will leave the bandaid in its packaging to keep it sterile, and decorate the packaging.

- Measure the size of the bandaid and/or the bandaid packaging.
- Cut the washi tape into strips.
- Place the washi tape over the Bandaid or the packaging.
- Using your scissors, trim as needed.
- Share with family and friends.
