Home Huddle Storytime and Questions:

Read together the story of Adam and Eve in your Spark Story Bible found on page 8. (If you need a Spark Story Bible, please let us know!) Once done reading, ask: What did Adam and Eve do in the garden? If you could name an animal a different name what would it be? How special was Adam and Eve to God? Did you know you are special to God, too?

Let's Do Some Art! Make a Garden Suncatcher. Hang it in a window to help you remember the beautiful plants that God created in our world.



Materials Included: Jar lid ring, 2 pieces of clear contact paper, permanent marker, ribbon

Materials From Home: Plant material- small flower blooms, petals, and/or leaves, scissors

What to do: Take a walk in your yard or neighborhood and gather flowers and leaves that you like. At home take out the contact paper and trace the outside rim of the jar ring onto the shiny side of one of the contact paper pieces. Peel off the backing of this piece of contact paper and lay it sticky side up. Place the flowers and leaves on the sticky paper inside the drawn circle. When your flowers are placed to your liking, peel the back off of the second piece of contact paper and place the sticky side down on top of the flowers. (sticky side to sticky side) press the pieces together around and in between the flowers. Cut out around the circle. Tie the piece of ribbon around the jar ring and place your flower circle inside the ring. If needed, you can tape or glue the circle in place.
