## **Home Huddle Storytime and Questions:**

Read together the story of The Good Samaritan in your Spark Story Bible found on page 360. (If you need a Spark Story Bible, please let us know!) Once done reading, ask: What happened to the man? Who helped him? Why did Jesus tell this story? How does this story help you understand your role in the world?

**Let's Do Some Art!** Make Good Samaritan coupons! Think of all of the things that you can do to help out different family members and neighbors. Let's make some coupons that you can pass out with jobs that you are able to help others with. Things like yard work, carrying in grocery bags, cleaning up around the house, or helping prepare a meal or snack for someone. Make up your own too!

Materials Included: Hand print papers (2), Job stickers, sticky hand

Materials From Home: Scissors, pens or markers

What to do: Cut out the 6 hands. Place one sticker on each of the hands. You can add your own job idea to the blank sticker and the extra hand. Write the name of the person you would like to give the coupon to on the other side of the hand or draw pictures. After you have given your coupons to family or friends, give yourself a HIGH FIVE. When you play with your sticky hands remember what it means to be a Good Samaritan and a good neighbor because when we care for others, God's love sticks with them.
