



Day 1 - Snack

Spark Bible Story: Adam & Eve, pg 8

Bible Verse: "God was happy to see that Adam and Eve were taking care of everything in creation."

Bible Buddy: Sammy Squirrel

Take Home Point: We are caretakers of the earth. Let's go God!



Set up:

- 12 Tables with 8 chairs at each table
- Each table should have a prayer tent.
- Water pitchers/cups
- Paper plates/napkins

Materials:

Fruit Loops (one small cup for each child to eat and a bowl of them on the table to make worms)

Chenille stem, sandwich bag with name if they want to keep their "worms"

Welcome:

Say: Today we are learning about the story of Adam and Eve and how God called them to take care of creation. They named the animals, and they could eat any fruit or vegetable from the garden. Adam and Eve were never hungry. They were lucky! We don't want you to be hungry either, so today we are making Fruit Loop worms

Here is what to do: Give each student a baggie. Write the student's name on the bag. Place a bowl of Fruit Loops on the table. Give each student a chenille stem. Have kids bend the end so that the loops won't fall off when threading them. Keep threading loops onto the stem until desired. Bend the end so that the loops won't fall off. Bend worm. Put the "worm" in the bag. Give each student a cup with Fruit Loops to eat.



Bible Point:

Leader: We are caretakers of the earth.

Everyone: Let's go God!
